Apostle Hugh Carmichael was born on January 3, 1935 in Dillon South Carolina to the late Ezzie and Herbert Carmichael. He transitioned from earthly labor to his heavenly reward on Thursday, January 25, 2018. Hugh attended public school in Dillon. He enjoyed reading, especially anything related to history. As according to tradition, at the age of twelve, Apostle Carmichael was baptized in the Pee Dee River.

In 1949 the Carmichael family relocated to Camden, New Jersey where Hugh worked faithfully in the family business, a neighborhood grocery store. Working closely with his father and because of the God given wisdom and knowledge he possessed, he was able to help his father manage the business/record keeping aspect. He also met and married Rebecca as a young man. It was in New Jersey where they started a family.

Eventually the family moved to Connecticut and he secured a job at American Brass in Ansonia. After a brief time in Ansonia they moved to New Haven. He became the Route Supervisor at the Jackson Newspaper, now known as the New Haven Register. Hugh held this position until he was called into full-time ministry.

When the Lord took Rebecca to her heavenly home, Hugh was heartbroken and distraught. He began to seek God for a help-meet. God spoke to him as he cried out to the Lord saying, "Joyce will help you". Just as God had promised, Joyce was in Philadelphia serving the Lord with her whole heart. They were married in 1973 and recently celebrated 45 years of marriage.
